Our first Walk-in will be Friday, September 16. Parents are invited to walk their children to homeroom, stay through the morning announcements, and then have refreshments in the Cougar Den with the principal. Hope to see all of you.

September 16 will also be *Cougar Spirit Day*. Students may come out of uniform. They may wear Corpus Christi Cougar jerseys, t-shirts or the school colors of orange and white. Students may also wear shorts.

First Quarter Mid-quarter reports will be distributed Friday, September 16. These forms must be signed and returned to school Monday, September 19.

We will offer training in the Child and Adolescent Protection Policy Tuesday, September 20 at 6:30. The class will be held in the Adult Education room in the Community Center. All adults who plan to volunteer in any capacity at Corpus Christi Catholic School or Parish must receive training for the Child and Adolescent Protection Policy. If you are unable to attend the session here on September 21, monthly sessions are held at St. Dominic School on the fourth WEDNESDAY (new day) of each month. **For parents who were trained last year, you will have to be retrained, but you will not have to attend a session. Go to the CAPP online training at www.mobilearchdiocese.org. You will have three articles to read and a short test to take. Once you have passed the test, we will be notified that you have been retrained. Remember, you must receive CAPP training in order to go on a field trip with your child. You must complete you retraining by October 31.**
