Principal's Notes September 19, 2011

Child and Adolescent Protection Policy training will be held tomorrow night, September 20 at 6:30. The class will be held in the Adult Education room in the Community Center. All adults who plan to volunteer in any capacity at Corpus Christi Catholic School or Parish must receive training for the Child and Adolescent Protection Policy. If you are unable to attend the session tomorrow, monthly sessions are held at St. Dominic School on the fourth WEDNESDAY of each month. For parents who were trained last year, you will have to be retrained, but you will not have to attend a session. Go to the CAPP online training at www.mobilearchdiocese.org. You will have articles to read and a short test to take. Once you have passed the test, we will be notified that you have been retrained. Remember, you must receive CAPP training in order to go on a field trip with your child. You must complete your retraining by October 31.

We will celebrate Grandparents' Day Tuesday, September 27. We will have a Mass and a reception for grandparents in the banquet hall. They will then be able to tour the school and visit their grandchildren's classrooms. Please tell your child/children's grandparents who their teacher is. This will make it easier for them to find their grandchildren.

October is Respect Life Month. We have two important activities planned for the month. First, we will teach the student lesson for the Child and Adolescent Protection Policy. Your child will bring home information for you to discuss. Second, we are raising money again for the 2-B Choices for Women Pregnancy Center. Each family will receive a baby bottle and be asked to fill it with loose change. The money raised will help 2B provide services to women and babies. Thank you for your generosity with this project.

The annual Blessing of the Animals, in honor of St. Francis of Assisi, will be Tuesday, October 4 after the 8:15 school Mass. Children may not bring their animals to school with them. You may meet your child in the parking lot about 9:00. After the blessing, all animals must be taken home. No animal is allowed to stay at school. All animals must be in a cage or on a leash. If you are not able to bring your child's pet, children may bring a picture of their pet. A special blessing will be offered for all pets, even those not present.
